## (I) Eligibility Qualifications for the post of <u>PROFESSOR</u> in CHEMICAL ENGINEERING & CHEMICAL TECHNOLOGY

#### <u>Essential</u>:

- (i) A **Ph.D. Degree** with **First Class** at Bachelor's or Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engg. & Tech. and
- (ii) Minimum experience of **ten years** in teaching, research and/or industry, out of which at least **five years** at the level of Associate Professor

-OR-

In the event the candidate is from industry and the profession, minimum of **thirteen years** experience in teaching and /or research and/or industry is essential.

## (iii) Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:

- 1. Post Ph.D. publications and guiding Ph.D. students is highly desirable at the appropriate branch of Engineering & Technology.
- 2. Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
- 3. Published work, such as research papers, patents filed / obtained, books, and / or technical reports;
- 4. Experience of guiding the project work / dissertation of PG / Research Students or supervising R & D projects in industry.
- 5. Demonstrated leadership in planning and organizing academic, research, industrial and/or professional activities; and
- 6. Capacity to undertake / lead sponsored R & D, consultancy and related activities.

# (II) Eligibility Qualifications for the post of <u>PROFESSOR</u> in <u>CHEMISTRY</u>

#### Essential:

- (i) A **Ph.D. Degree** with Master's Degree in Chemistry with **First Class** or equivalent at Bachelor's or Master's Level from any recognized Indian University.
- (ii) A minimum of **ten years** of teaching experience in University/College, and/or experience in research at the University/National level Institutions/Industries out of which five years should be at the at the level of Associate Professor including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.

-OR-

Minimum of **thirteen years** of teaching experience in University/College, and/or experience in research at the University/National level Institutions/Industries.

- (iii) Evidence of published work with a minimum of four publications with good impact factor in International Journal of repute.
- (iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based on performance based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in AICTE Regulations, 2012.
- (v) Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:
  - 1. Experience of guiding the project work / dissertation of PG / Research Students or supervising R & D projects in industry.
  - 2. Demonstrated leadership in planning and organizing academic, research, industrial and/or professional activities; and
  - 3. Capacity to undertake / lead sponsored R & D, consultancy and related activities.

## (III) Eligibility Qualifications for the post of <u>ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR</u> in CHEMICAL TECHNOLOGY

#### **Essential:**

- (i) A **Ph.D. Degree** with **First Class** at Bachelor's or Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering & Technology and
- (ii) Minimum of **five years** experience in teaching/research/industry of which 2 years post Ph.D. experience is desirable.
- (iii) Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:
  - 1. Post Ph.D. publications and guiding Ph.D. student is highly desirable.
  - 2. Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
  - 3. Published work, such as research papers, patents filed / obtained, books, and / or technical reports;
  - 4. Experience of guiding the project work / dissertation of PG / Research Students or supervising R & D projects in industry.

# (IV) Eligibility Qualifications for the post of <u>ASSISTANT PROFESSOR</u> in CHEMICAL ENGINEERING & CHEMICAL TECHNOLOGY

(i) <u>Essential</u>:

B.E./B.Tech. and M.E./M.Tech. in relevant branch with **First class** or equivalent either in B.E./B.Tech. or M.E./M.Tech.

- (ii) Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:
  - 1. Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
    - 2. Papers presented at Conferences and / or in refereed journals.

## (V) Eligibility Qualifications for the post of <u>ASSISTANT PROFESSOR</u> in HUMANITIES

### (i) <u>Essential</u>:

- (i) Master's Degree in **English & Economics** with **First Class** or equivalent at Bachelor's or Master's Level from any recognized Indian University.
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualification, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test **(NET)** conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- (iii) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (i) & (ii) to this clause; a candidate who has a **Ph.D. Degree** awarded before 2009, or has been awarded a Ph.D. degree after 2009 in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of **NET/SLET/SET** for recruitment and appointment as Assistant Professor in Technical Institutions.
- (ii) Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:
  - Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;
  - 2. Papers presented at Conferences and / or in refereed journals.

### NOTES, INSTRUCTIONS, TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- 1. - 2. An applicant is required to submit separate application for each post and reserved category.
- 3. Self-attested copies of the certificates should be attached in support of information given in the form where necessary and serial No. of enclosure attached should be indicated in the respective column given in the form. Any information contained in the attached certificates shall not be considered unless it is claimed in the application form.
- 4. Prescribed qualifications would be as per the Norms/Regulations of AICTE/UGC & as amended from time to time and as approved by the Government of Maharashtra.
- 5. The candidate applying for the post of <u>PROFESSOR IN CHEMISTRY</u> is strictly required to submit duly filled Academic Performance Indicator (API) form which is to be filled as per norms set out in AICTE Regulations-2012 (as amended from time to time). Candidates are advised to visit the website of the AICTE/relevant statutory councils for details, if required.
- 6. The candidate should submit his/her Bio-data alogwith the application form.

- 8. The period of time taken by candidates to acquire M. Phil. and/ or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching / research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions.
- 9. As per provision under section 102(4) of Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016, for the post of Professor, the Selection Committee may in preference to the candidates who have applied and appeared before it, recommend for appointment, with all the requisite details, the name of any other person who may not have applied or appeared before it, but who is duly qualified and has to his/her credit exceptionally high academic achievements or proficiency in the specialization or has extraordinary academic contribution, to be recorded in writing.
- 10. The minimum period of probation shall be one year extendable by a maximum period of one more year in case of unsatisfactory performance.
- 11. Candidates belonging to the reserved categories specified by the state Government of Maharashtra only shall be considered for the posts

- reserved in this advertisement. The candidates from reserved category who are domiciled outside the State of Maharashtra will be treated as Open category candidates as per Maharashtra Govt. Circular No. CBS-1290/23116/Pra.Kra.378/ Mapak.5, dated 24-08-1995.
- 12. As per the Govt. Resolution No. Aniyo-1005/126/Seva-4 dated 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2005 a new "Defined contribution pension scheme" has been made applicable to the Govt. servant, who are recruited on or after 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2005. The same will be applicable to employees of this Institute.
